

## TRAVEL INFORMATION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAGEN



### By airplane

There are 3 relevant airports near Hagen.

- *Düsseldorf* – From here, you need to take a train to Hagen which takes around 1 hour.
- *Frankfurt* – Many flights from abroad arrive in Frankfurt. From here it is a 3 hour train ride to Hagen.
- *Cologne* – Another relevant airport is Cologne. From the airport you should first take a train to the central station, from here it is a 45 minute train ride to Hagen. Trains leave every 30 minutes.
- *Dortmund* – From here, you need to take the airport shuttle bus to the train station “Holzwickede, Bahnhof”, from here you need to a train to Hagen. Trains leave every 20 – 30 minutes. The whole trip is a 45 minutes journey.

## By train

- From Hagen's main train station you may take the bus lines 514, 515, and 527. Line 515 and 527 are direct lines to the university, which will take you +/- 25 minutes. When taking line 514, descend at Hagen Hoheleye. From there it's a 5 minute walk to the university. Both lines leave several times every hour.
- Taxis are available from at the main station. Guests may contact this service by calling +492331/125555 and +492334/580800

## By car

Situated along the most important highways of Germany (A1, A45, and A46), Hagen has a very convenient location reachable from every direction by car. The university itself has sufficient parking facilities. How to get to the University of Hagen by car:

- *Coming from the north (Hamburg, Hanover, Münster, Dortmund)*  
When taking the A1 highway, follow the direction to the junction Hagen-Nord
- *Coming from the west (Saarbrücken, Trier, Cologne)*  
Via the A1 highway to the junction Hagen-West
- *From the south (Munich, Würzburg, Frankfurt, Siegen)*  
Take highway A45 (Sauerland line) to the highway intersection Hagen
- *From the east (Arnsberg, Iserlohn)*  
Take highway A46 (Wuppertschnellweg) to the junction Hagen

### Relevant information:

It is recommendable to use the Journey Planner to find your travel information. Use the values "Düsseldorf Flughafen" for the from-field and "Hagen Hbf" for the destination field. It will give you a connection using local trains.
